

# Tsuyoshi Takamura

Director/ Technical Director

Born in Kumamoto, Japan in 1978, Tsuyoshi graduated from Kyushu Institute of Design (Department of Visual Communication Design) in 2001. He then joined KOO-KI in 2003 and is a director/ technical director. His earlier works include directing and producing motion graphics, VFX and 3DCG. Recently his focus has been more on planning and producing interactive visuals using programming, aiming for the fusion of visual and interactive experiences in a “hybrid of the interactive visual”. He brings this wealth of expertise when exploring different platforms such as apps, web, and AR/VR to further his horizons. “Mr. shape’s Touch Card,” an educational app featuring Mr. shape, won the Good Design Award (2013) and was one of Japan Media Arts Festival’s Jury Selections (2011). The app has been downloaded over 1,000,000 times, too. “Planet Planter”, is a permanent exhibition at Fukuoka City Science Museum, “Planet Planter” won Tsuguhiko Kadokawa Prize at Digital Ehon Award (2018).

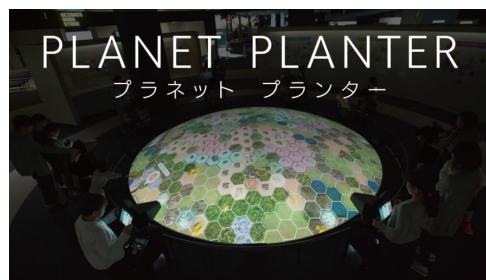

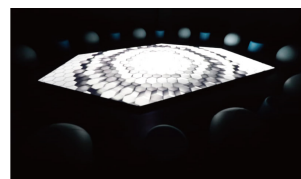

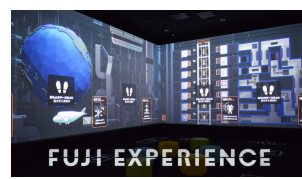
